INTRODUCTION

Over the past three years, our congregation has committed to an extraordinary capital campaign to build an expanded sanctuary in response to the growth that the Lord has blessed us with here at Christ the Lord Lutheran Church and School. As the “Faith, Family, Future (FFF)” campaign comes to a close, it is evident that the Lord has blessed our efforts in ways that we did not even anticipate.

In 2018, we set a goal of raising \$3 million over the 3-year FFF campaign. Around \$2.2 million was committed at the start of the campaign as we continued to explore what a sanctuary expansion would look like. **Incredibly, the total FFF offerings received are projected to be over \$3.2 million. To God be the glory!**

We look back on the blessings that God has showered upon us over the past three years. We thank God and all of you for the generous outpouring of time, talent, and treasure from the entire congregation towards this effort.


WHAT NOW?

The theme selected for this exciting, new process is “Faith, Family, Future 2.”


CAMPAIGN GOAL: \$1 MILLION OVER 3 YEARS

Our goal is to raise \$1,000,000 over a three-year period to be received in the calendar years of 2022, 2023, and 2024, in order to accomplish the following:

- 1 SERVICE DEBT** obligations related to our capital projects.
- 2 BUILD** an early childhood center on the east side of the building.
- 3 EXPAND** grades K-8 in our current facility to meet the needs of increased enrollment and outreach opportunities.

This is a pivotal time in our congregation, as we look forward to the future of both our church and school. **With God’s blessing, our goal is to raise \$1,000,000 over a three-year period to be received in the calendar years of 2022, 2023, and 2024.** The funds raised will be applied toward the expenses associated with our church and school capital projects.
